The Board has finalised our Charter and Strategic Plan and our Strategic Property Plan. Both documents have been the culmination of many months work beginning last year with our Community Consultation. Our Strategic Goals for the next three years will centre on:

- Our Special Character

- Sustainability and Environmental Awareness.

These strategic goals were selected based on the feedback from the school community last year.
