Brainbreak

Every morning around 10am our tamariki have a very quick break along with a piece of fresh fruit or vegetable, which helps them to remain focused through to 11am morning tea. Please note, the children are **not allowed fruit sticks**, **muesli bars or any other type of**



snack during brain break time. The break is intended to enhance learning and not interrupt it. If your child prefers their fruit cut up please help them by ensuring it is in a separate container from their lunchbox, and is easy to access.

Attendance Dues and Donations 2023

Attendance Dues are a compulsory payment approved by the Minister of Education under the terms of the Education and Training Act 2020. They are a condition of enrolment at Good Shepherd School, as they are in all Catholic schools in Aotearoa New Zealand. Attendance Dues are collected by Good Shepherd School on behalf of the school's Proprietor, the Roman Catholic Bishop of Auckland. Thank you to all of our families that have made payments already and to our families who have made per term, per week and per fortnight arrangements.

Good Shepherd School also asks for **donations** from whānau. We rely on these donations to provide the extra learning opportunities, such as the *Opera in Schools* performance in week 5, and the exceptional resources available to our students, such as one-to-one devices in our classrooms. These donations include *Trips and Activities* and, where relevant, camp donations so that we can offer our students a range of rich education outside the classroom experiences. As a small school, we very much appreciate these contributions to our limited budget.
