Absences - MAKE SURE YOU NOTIFY US

Please notify the school office of any student absences and the reason before 9:15 am on the day of absence. Notify by phone on 09 620 4962,email admin@goodshepherd.school.nz or log on to your 'School App' and notify absence. Remember to inform the school of the reason so we can code your child's absence accordingly.

Signing in Late/Signing out Students

If your child will be arriving late for school you must stop by the School Office to sign them in before you take them to class. Similarly if you are picking your child up from school for an offsite appointment you must also sign them out at the school office.

 If you do not come through the office when your child is late, your child will not be marked on the morning roll which may result in a phone call from the office. To avoid confusion, if your child arrives after 8.50am ALWAYS come through the office before going to class.

Good Shepherd Uniform

ALL children are expected to be in their full Summer Uniform in Terms 1 and 4. This includes black sandals and a navy wide-brim hat. NO BASEBALL CAPS.

Children with long hair MUST have their hair tied back, during school hours. A watch and plain silver or gold ear studs are the only jewellery permitted with the school uniform.
