Religious Education- Communion of Saints Te Kotahitanga o Te Hunga

This term our strand focus is the Communion of Saints - those people who have officially been declared Saints of the Church because of their own virtues and holiness-tapu and mana of their lives. These Saints inspire us, and lead us to God in a way that we too can be Saints if we choose. Some very important days that follow this strand are All Saints' Day (Friday 1st November – Good Shepherd School attend Mass at 9am) and All Souls' Day (Saturday 2nd November. All Saints' Day is a day that we celebrate ALL the Saints in Heaven. It's a day to pray to the Saints and ask them to intercede for us. This includes ALL the Saints, even the ones who we don't realise are Saints. Not all holy people who have died and gone to heaven are canonized by the Church. All Souls' Day is a day we focus on prayer for those who have died. These souls need our prayers to help them to get into Heaven.

All Saints' Day Friday 1 November

Please join us as the whole school joins the parish community for 9am Mass on All Saints' Day.

All Souls' Day Saturday 2 November

All Souls Day is a more solemn day for families when we can remember the dead spiritually and also remind our children about their ancestors. At the 6pm Vigil Mass Monsignor Bernard will be having a candle lighting for loved ones who have died, within Mass. You are warmly invited to attend this special occasion.
