We are of course, very open to discussing student wellbeing within their class, but we do request that you allow your child at least three weeks to settle in first.

#### **Leadership Assembly**


You are warmly invited to this assembly on Friday 13 December at 9am. We will acknowledge our student leaders and say farewell to Mrs Drummond.
