#### **Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)**

In line with advice from the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Health, Good Shepherd School is focusing on encouraging good hygiene practices as a preventative to the spread of illness. These include:

- Washing hands with soap and water before and after eating as well as after attending the toilet
- Covering coughs and sneezes with clean tissues or with an elbow
- Putting used tissues in the bin
- Encouraging staff and students to stay home if they are unwell

Advice from the Ministry of Health asks everyone to wash your hands often and thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, making sure you dry them thoroughly. Singing Happy Birthday twice, slowly should take about 20 seconds. You might want to work out what other song you could sing along to at home - or you could say two 'Hail Marys' slowly!
