A letter will come home to you on Thursday 10 December advising you of your child's placement next year, and will also give you some information on stationery requirements for 2021.

Class placements for 2021 are final. We appreciate the trust you show in our professional judgement by not requesting particular placements (or attempting to change placements) for your children. We are of course, very open to discussing student wellbeing within their class, but we do request that you allow your child at least three weeks to settle in first.
