Information for Whānau Waitangi Day Saturday 6 February 2021

Waitangi Day is New Zealand's national day. It is a holiday held annually on 6 February to commemorate the signing of the Treaty of Waitangi - New Zealand's founding document - on 6 February 6th 1840. Because Waitangi Day falls on the weekend, Monday 8 February will be observed as a holiday and school will be closed.

COVID-19 Reminders

Recent cases are a reminder that we should all be consistently using the NZ COVID Tracer App and turning bluetooth tracking on.


Concerns and Complaints

Netsafe Tips for Parents

Managing children's access to, and time on, digital devices continues to be an area that we work closely on with our whānau. We hope the tips we include in our newsletters are helpful to you.

Set expectations

Talk to your child about the type of behaviours you'd like them to adopt.

- how long they should spend online (tips on timing)
- what apps and social media sites you'd like them to use
- what is appropriate content to view.

This will be different depending on the age of your child, and what you feel comfortable with. Technological options like <u>parental controls</u> can help, but it needs to be teamed with online safety education.
