Absences should be communicated to the school office via email, school app or telephone before 8.45am.

Early Arrivals at School

We are having an increasing number of children arriving at school very early in the morning. While it is lovely to have our children eager to get to school, they should not be arriving before 8.30am. Classrooms open at 8.30am and teachers cannot

supervise children before this time. Our OSCA programme runs from 7.30am to 8.30am for those children whose parents need to drop them off early.


