project has the title Te Ara a Maria: Mary's Way and runs for 12 months from 15 August.




# PLASTICINE ART

# Did you know about the Good Shepherd School SKI TEAM?


The Primary School Ski Championships will run from Monday 30 August to Wednesday 1 September at Whakapapa ski field.
