NZ Catholics urged to join Pope Francis next Friday in prayer for Ukraine

The bishops are asking NZ Catholics to support everyone caught in the Ukraine war by going to your local parish church at a time to suit you next Friday to pray the Rosary. This coincides with Pope Francis consecrating Ukraine and Russia to the Immaculate Heart of Mary the same day. Bishop Steve (Bishop of Auckland and NZCBC Secretary) says: "All over Ukraine, people are having to flee their homes because of the war. Leaving our homes here to go to our local church to pray on this special day would very much be showing solidarity to the people having to leave their homes in Ukraine."

Prayer for Ukraine

"Prayer for Ukraine" is a hymn composed in 1885, during a time when the Ukrainian language was suppressed by the government of Imperial Russia. The text is by poet Oleksandr Konynsky and the music by composer Mykola Lysenko. It is used as a hymn by the various churches in Ukraine, including the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church and the Ukrainian Orthodox Church, and became a spiritual anthem for Ukraine. 
