This week we enjoyed our first whole-school expedition in a very long time. Our visit to the zoo was drenched in sunshine, wonder, and of course learning, which continues in the classroom.

Before we left, we spoke to our tamariki about the importance of displaying our school values of care, honesty and respect - wherever we are. We told them that we knew that staff and patrons from Auckland Zoo would be very impressed!

Sure enough, at the zoo I saw our values in action. For example care, by reaching out to other students who seemed a little downcast, honesty, by taking responsibility for their actions and correcting them before they impacted others, and respect, by opening the door for visitors who had their hands full of toddlers and pushchairs. None of us gets everything right all of the time, but each time our tamariki make an effort like this, our values become a little more part of them. At the end of the day, the children getting off the bus looked exhausted but happy.

For many children the trip outside our school environment without their parents was a new challenge. Kapai! Speaking of challenges, we have been working on speeches lately. Like so many adults, some of our ākonga are well out of their comfort zone when addressing an audience. We applaud them in starting the journey to ensure their voice will always be heard when it needs to be - no matter how many people are listening.

Our thoughts are with the communities affected by the recent devastating weather events particularly at the top of the South Island.

Healthy Tamariki

COVID-19 Guidance

• If your child has COVID-19 symptoms, the child and anyone in their household with similar symptoms should be tested for COVID-19.

· If any household members are COVID-19 positive, other household members are at high risk of becoming infected. Everyone must isolate for at least seven days from the day that the first person receives their positive test result or becomes symptomatic (whichever is earliest).

• All household contacts, including children, need to take a rapid antigen test (RAT) on day three and day seven, or sooner if they develop symptoms. A person who has had COVID-19 in the past 90 days, does not need to isolate again as a household contact.

• Anyone who experiences symptoms 29 days or longer after previous COVID-19 infection should test and will need to isolate if they test positive. *If your child:*

 \cdot has been isolating with COVID 19 and is feeling

well after seven days, they can return to school · continues to be unwell and/or has symptoms after their seven-day isolation period has ended, they should remain at home to recover until 24 hours after their symptoms end

 \cdot still feels unwell or their symptoms are worsening after ten days, they should not return to school. Call your GP or Healthline on 0800 611 116 for medical advice.

Good Shepherd OSCA

Our before and after school care programme is an important service to our school community and every care is taken to guard children's safety and wellbeing while they are at OSCA. This means that children will not be released to anyone other than the person or people nominated on our records unless contact has been made by that person to advise a change. A couple of extra reminders:

Good Shepherd School Uniform Heads Up!

We are tightening up on correct uniform attire, as some children have been slipping a little bit. Please take the opportunity to ensure that your child is wearing their correct school uniform:

Winter Uniform: Students wear winter uniform in Terms 2 & 3. This includes black knee high socks and black shoes.

Sports Uniform: Compulsory for Years 4, 5 and 6. Jewellery, nail polish, makeup, hair

A watch and ear studs are the only jewellery permitted with the school uniform. Nail polish is not permitted on either fingers or toes. Makeup may not be worn. Long hair must be tied back. Hair accessories must be either navy blue or black.
