### From the Principal

Dear Parents, Caregivers and Whānau,

Last Saturday it was lovely to have whānau join us for a picnic on the school grounds followed by our inaugural school Mass in the Good Shepherd Parish Church. The weather forecast was not great for Auckland however, the sun shone down on Balmoral that day! Thank you to Monsignor Bernard Kiely who made Mass unique to our kura and gave us much to consider as we enter the new school year. I would like to acknowledge Miss Kaur our Acting Director of Religious studies for her organisation of both our first prayer assembly of the year last Friday and her contribution towards the inaugural school Mass.

On Tuesday night the Good Shepherd team were in attendance for the annual Dedication Mass for staff in Catholic schools celebrated by Bishop Steve. This was a large event hosting up to 800 members of staff.

During our Ash Wednesday Mass Monsignor Bernard Kiely reminded children there is a yellow prayer box in front of the statue of St Joseph where children can write down prayers and place these for support from the congregation. He also encouraged children and families to take the opportunity in the morning before school starts, to say prayer in the church.

Finally, our year 6 children returned to school after a very successful five day camp at MERC, Long Bay.

Following this camp all year 6 children have been designated areas of leadership and responsibility within our kura. As a community we shall encourage and support these student leaders to motivate, inspire and be role models for the younger tamariki in our school.

Remember to inform the school of the reason so we can code your child's absence accordingly.

#### **Signing in Late/Signing out Students**

If your child will be arriving late for school you must stop by the School Office to sign them in before you take them to class. Similarly if you are picking your child up from school for an offsite appointment you must also sign them out at the school office.

 If you do not come through the office when your child is late, your child will not be marked on the morning roll which may result in a phone call from the office. To avoid confusion, if your child arrives after 8.50am ALWAYS come through the office before going to class.

Attendance Dues Primary School Y0 - Y8 will be increasing in 2024 to \$129 per term (\$516 per year) including GST.

#### **Good Shepherd Uniform**

ALL children are expected to be in their full Summer Uniform in Terms 1 and 4. This includes black sandals and a navy wide-brim hat. NO BASEBALL CAPS. If a child does not bring their hat to school they must stay in the shade during morning tea and lunchtime breaks.

Children with long hair MUST have their hair tied back, during school hours. A watch and plain silver or gold ear studs are the only jewellery permitted with the school uniform.
