Dear Parents, Caregivers and Whānau,

As we move through Holy Week, the most sacred week in the liturgical calendar, we remember the Passion of Jesus and celebrate his resurrection.

It is hard to believe that we are approaching week 10 of the school term already. With this comes the change in weather and a reminder that we need our children to keep warm and dry.


